Open Space Comments

- 1 Reduce nighttime light pollution (redirect lights down, etc) that kills seeing nighttime sky fireflies, etc
- 2 Community center of a size for people to get to know each other
- 3 Clean up green space along lakeshore @ SH66 boat ramp and Willow Bend and add trail if possible (x2)

- 4 Organize nature trail along lake shore adjacent to 66 boat ramp. It's currently used w/ cars. Dangerous (x2)
- 5 Pay attention to brick & mortar vs. green in overall plan. More green = better air
- 6 Use lake perimeter for trails!
- 7 Why aren't we focusing on a destination lake shore along Hubbard like Whiterock trail? (x2)
- 8 Develop multi-use open space with scenic qualities (leverage Rockwall's unique beauty)
- 9 Allow motorized vehicles such as golf carts or scooters
- 10 Multi use of lake area, parks, etc
- 11 A place to watch the sunset on the lake
- 12 Too little time for public participation!!!

- 14 Enforce open space guidelines on developers vs making constant exceptions

- 15 Local farm/gardens and local farmers market enlarged (local food)
- 16 The rock wall really needs to be a visible and accessible landmark
- 17 Better markings on Squabble Creek Trails
- 18 Create non-profit to support open space
- 19 Age diverse activities
- 20 Make nice soccer and baseball fields for young working families
- 21 I would like to see a park with a butterfly habitat clearly marked - i.e. milkweed w/ information signs of life cycle, nectar plants, and family wildflower photo area
- 22 I like the idea of having some access to the rock wall. I am also concerned that human access = destruction. Same goes for some open spaces including wildlife areas. Consider some spaces not being accessible, but preserved.
- 23 It was mentioned that the balance of private interests and public concerns is "tricky to do". It must be said that the Lake Ray Hubbard waterfront (connection option 9) would significantly and unnecessarily exacerbate that "trickiness"
- 24 I would like to have another treed park like Harry Myers Park, with a water pond area for families

- 25 Map markup (northern edge of county near Breezy Hill): Historic 1800's era stone structure on Riggs property Strickland tract under threat of P. Development. Just discovered.
- 26 Map markup (northern edge of county between Breezy Hill and Anna Cade). Oldest structure in Rockwall County, rock house on Rock House Ranch
